With regards to September, we will be following the Stoke-on-Trent Local Authority guidelines. Although we do not know what September will bring, this is what to expect:

- classes will not exceed 30 and children will sit in pairs on desks arranged into rows at a distance of 1m+ (EYFS will have carpet spaces, which will be 1m+),
- children will be kept in Key Stage bubbles during play times and lunch times and they will have separate areas to play in,
- Y1-Y6 children will eat lunch in their classrooms and EYFS will eat lunch in the hall,
- breakfast club will be available from 7.30am on Wednesday 2nd September onwards (book as usual from Tuesday 1st September on a first come, first serve basis),
- 'Cuckoos' after school care club can be booked from Tuesday 1st September and **will begin on Wednesday 2nd September and is on until 6.00pm from Monday to Friday,**
- **start of the day: gates will be open from 7.30 am for breakfast club until 8.30 am and then again at 8.30 am for the start of school, only one parent, where possible, to accompany children to class and please use our ONE WAY SYSTEM;**
Y3-Y6 children will be expected to be in class by 8.40am and we would like the children to walk to the school building from the gates/carpark by themselves where possible;
EYFS-Y2 children will be expected to be in class by 9.00am;
- **end of the day: gates will be open from 2.45 pm;**
- car parking and the drop off zone will be available before and after school - use the one way system to exit, our gates are open from 7.30 am for breakfast club;
- after school clubs will be postponed until further notice,
- educational visits will be postponed until the second half of the Autumn term.

If you have any questions then do not hesitate to call the school office and we will get back to you. We will continue to follow any new guidance that the LA or the DfE provides.

After these strange and challenging times, we are very much looking forward to welcoming you all back to our familiar and safe environment in September, we wish you all a relaxing, happy summer. Stay safe and see you all soon.
