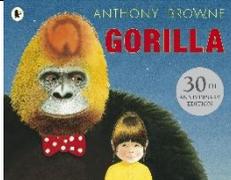
Enclosed in this letter is an overview of all the exciting learning your child will be completing this half term. As you can see, we're going to be very busy!

## English



During this half term we will be looking at the book 'Gorilla' by Anthony Brown. We will look at some poetry around families and discuss characters' thoughts and feelings. We will be writing a retell of the story.

## Maths

During our first half term in Year 3, we will be recapping and building on our skill surrounding place value. This involves representing, partitioning and comparing hundreds, tens and ones, as well as using these skills to develop our Addition and Subtraction knowledge later on in the term.



## Science



Our first Science topic this year is 'Food and the Digestive System'. This project teaches children about the human digestive system. They explore the main parts, starting with the mouth and teeth, identifying teeth types and their functions. They link this learning to animals' diets and construct food chains to show the flow of energy.

## RE

In our RE lessons this half term, our main focus is the story of 'Noah's Ark', who was Noah, why God chose Noah and how this story relates to Christians and their lives today. We will also be looking into Christian weddings and the promises that are made to God and each other during the ceremony.



## PSHE



Our PSHE lessons are all about 'Healthy me'. We will be looking at different ways to keep ourselves healthy and safe through exercise, food choices and emergency services.

## History

This term our topic is called 'Invasion'. Children will learn about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. Children will learn about Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest.



## PE



In our PE lessons, we will have two focus', our indoor lessons will focus on dodgeball and our outdoor PE lessons will be building skills surrounding tag rugby. Both sports will support the children's development of team work, movement, throwing, catching and dodging.

## Art

Our Art topic this half term is all about colour theory and exploring colours, by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours, warm and cool colours and how and why artists use certain colours in their artwork.



## French



In our French lessons this half term we will be focusing on the basic skills needed to begin to converse in French. We will be exploring simple greetings, simple questions, numbers and colours.

## Computing

During this half term we will be recapping the importance of e-safety and how to keep ourselves safe online as well as developing our knowledge further of what we can use computers for and their many uses.
