
Dear Parents and Carers,

English	 <p>In English, our book is Troll Swap, where Tabitha swaps places with a hairy troll. During the half term, we will be writing simple sentences, focussing on capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and adding in conjunctions such as 'and', 'because'.</p>
Mathematics	<p>During this half term, some of the objectives in maths are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Numbers to 10• Part Whole within 10• Addition within 10

Science	 <p>In Science, children will learn about the basic needs of humans for survival, including the importance of exercise, nutrition and good hygiene. They learn how human offspring grow and change over time into adulthood.</p>
RE	 <p>In RE, pupils will learn about the concept of 'Gospel' and the good news of forgiveness, peace and love that Christians believe Jesus brings.</p>
PSHE	 <p>In PSHE, children will learn to explain how to keep their body safe and healthy, the impact of healthy choices, and how to keep themselves clean and healthy.</p>
Geography	 <p>The children will learn about atlases, maps and cardinal compass points. They learn about the characteristics of the four countries of the United Kingdom and find out why there are hot, temperate and cold places around the world. They also compare England to Somalia.</p>
PE	 <p>In PE, children will learn to: To hit a target, To defend a target, To roll and slide balls and Beanbags, To shoot in a game to get points, To work with a partner to score Points, To use our attacking and defending skills in a game</p>
Art	 <p>In Art children will learn about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours, hues and how artists use colour in their artwork.</p>
Computing	 <p>In Computing, we will be looking at online safety and Information Technology around us.</p>
