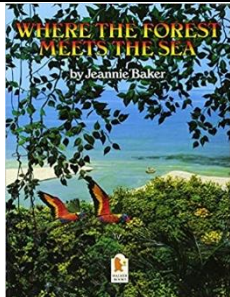
Enclosed in this letter is an overview of all the exciting learning your child will be completing this half term. As you can see, we're going to be very busy!

English



This half term, we will be reading *Where the Forest Meets the Sea* and using it as inspiration to learn about rainforests. The children will create a non-fiction information leaflet. They will develop skills in researching facts, organising information, using subject-specific vocabulary, and presenting their work clearly for a reader.

Maths



This half term in Maths, we will be developing our understanding of decimals, building on our prior knowledge of fractions. Later in the term, we will move on to exploring money and time.

Science



This half term in science we are looking at electrical circuits and conductors. The children will learn about electrical appliances and safety. They will get the opportunity to construct simple series circuits and name their parts and functions, including switches, wires and cells.

RE



This term in RE, pupils will explore 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We will be looking at the bible story 'The Good Samaritan', the choices that the 'Fishers of men' had to make and exploring what kind of world Jesus wanted.

PSHCE

Our PSHE lessons will focus on the theme 'Relationships'. We will explore the characteristics of a good freindship, look at how to deal with conflicts within freindships and valueing and remembering special memories and people in our lives.



Geography



This term we will continue our topic called 'Misty Mountain, Winding River'. Children will be looking at the physical processes of a river, sea or ocean and how they can change over time. They will be locating and exploring significant rivers and mountains around the world. Children will also be explaining ways that settlements, land use or water systems are used in the UK and around the world.

PE



In our PE lessons this half term, we will be focussing Boccia which is a sport from the Paralympics, as well as practicing our athletic skills getting ready for this years sports day!

Art

Our Art topic this half term is on Statues, Statuettes and Figurines. We will look at drawing skills and sculpture skills when recreating our own figurines. We will also be looking at some famous statues around the world, what they are made out of and how to create our own clay sculptures based around the Sumerian civilisation.



French



This half term in French children will be learning about being at school (A l'ecole). In this unit the children will learn 10 school subjects in French. The children will be able to talk about which subjects they like and dislike at school (along with a justification) and at what time/day they study various subjects.

Computing



In computing this half term, we will be looking at creating media specifically desktop publishing. The children will use programmes such as word and power point to create images and text. We look at the advantages and disadvantages of texts and images.
