Enclosed in this letter is an overview of all the exciting learning your child will be completing this half term. As you can see, we're going to be very busy!

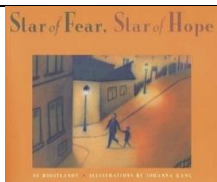
As part of our learning in Geography, we'll be delving into maps and looking at how land use changes depending on climate and topography.

English



Our learning will be based around the text, 'Star of Fear, Star of Hope' by Jo Hoestlandt. Set in France, during World War II, Helen recalls the mounting persecution of her Jewish friend. We will be looking at many of the grammatical

features used in the text, including expanding noun phrases, relative clauses and dialogue.

Mathematics



During the half term, the children will learn to:
Read and write numbers up to 10,000,000.
Compare and order numbers.
Learn Roman numerals up to 1,000.
Use negative numbers in context.
Use formal written methods to solve problems.

Compare, order and simplify fractions.

French

Our French for this half term will be learning about 'the date'. The children will learn how to write and say the date and when their birthdays and other special days are.



Science



In the Circulatory System project, your child will revisit prior learning about the systems in the human body and the seven life processes. They will explore the role of the circulatory system and its main parts, carrying out research to answer their own questions.

RE

Within this unit, pupils will find out about the importance of creation within the 'Big Story' of the Bible. They will study Genesis 1 and find out about how different Christians may interpret this text in different ways.



PSHE



In the topic "Healthy Me," the children will be learning about the impacts of smoking, alcohol and their relationship with food. The topic covers body image and the effects of external influences.

Geography

During the Our Changing World project, your child will revise the features of the Earth and learn more about time zones. They will recall how to use lines of latitude and longitude to pinpoint places on a world map and learn about map scale. They will measure distances on a map and revisit grid references, contour lines and map symbols.



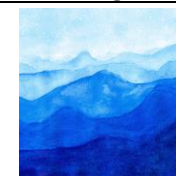
PE



During PE lessons, the children will be taking part in Tag Rugby and Badminton. In addition to developing their skills in these disciplines, they will also be learning the rules for the sports. Year 6 will also be going swimming.

Art

In 'Colour and Style,' the children will revisit learning about colour theory, including primary, secondary, tertiary, complementary, analogous, warm and cool colours, hues, tints, shades and tones.



Computing



In this unit, learners explore how data is transferred over the internet. Learners initially focus on addressing before moving on to the makeup and structure of data packets.
