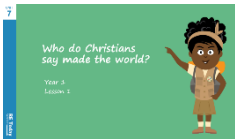
Dear Parents and Carers,

English	 Grammarsaurus Labels, Lists and Captions Units Year 1	In English, pupils will be working on writing lists, captions and labels and orally retelling a story.
Mathematics	During this half term, some of the objectives in maths are: • Numbers to 10 • Part whole within 10 • Addition within 10	

Science		In Science, this project teaches children that objects are made from materials. They identify a range of everyday materials and their sources. Children investigate the properties of materials and begin to recognise that a material's properties define its use.
RE		In RE, pupils will learn about the Christian belief that God created the world and why Christians care for creation.
PSHE		This half term in PSHE, pupils will explore 'Being Me in My World', learning about belonging, feelings, and rights and responsibilities.
History		This half term we will teach the children about everyday life and families today, including comparisons with childhood in the 1950s, using artefacts and a range of different sources.
PE		During PE this half term, pupils will learn the topics Send and Return and Attack, Defend, Shoot, developing skills to send and return objects, hit and shoot at targets, attack and defend in games, rally with a partner, move confidently to return a ball, and work cooperatively to score points.
Art		In Art children will learn about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of primary and secondary colours and how artists use colour in their artwork.
Computing	Technology around us	In Computing, pupils will develop their keyboard and mouse skills, learn about the parts of a computer, and begin to use technology safely and responsibly.
