We raised £858.02 Thank you so much


























Smart Uniform

Measles Information



The MMR vaccine is free and a safe and effective way of protecting against measles, mumps and rubella.

- 2 doses of the MMR vaccine provide the best protection against measles, mumps and rubella. The MMR vaccine is given to babies and young children as part of the NHS vaccination schedule. 1st dose given at 1 year and 2nd dose given at 3 years and 4 months.
- It's important to catch up on any missed vaccines. You can still ask your GP surgery for the MMR vaccine if your child has missed either of these 2 doses.

Measles

- Measles is highly contagious and can lead to complications such as ear infections, pneumonia, and inflammation of the brain which require hospitalisation and on rare occasions can lead to long term disability or death.
- Spending 15 minutes or more in direct contact with someone infected with measles is enough to catch the
 infection. People whose immunity is compromised, pregnant women and unvaccinated children are at
 increased risk of severe disease.
- Measles symptoms to be aware of include:

high fever

sore, red, watery eyes

coughing

aching and feeling generally unwell

a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms.

- Anyone with symptoms that could be measles is advised to stay at home and phone their GP or NHS 111
 for advice, rather than visiting the surgery or A&E. This is because measles spreads very quickly and easily
 and so it is important to try and prevent the illness spreading further.
- People who have symptoms should also especially try to stay away from areas where you could come into contact with vulnerable people such as schools, nurseries or care homes.
- Measles usually starts to get better in about a week.
- Stay off nursery, school, or work for at least 4 days from when the rash first appears.
